

Award 8 - Mark Pompei Student Scholarship

This award is presented to an individual who is a part-time student of learning and development in recognition of academic excellence and a commitment to the field of learning and development.

Eligibility

AITD membership is not required. The nominee must be a part-time student of an accredited formal study program working towards a first qualification in the field of training and development.

About this Award

In 1993, this scholarship was presented for the first time in memory of Mark Pompei, a young Staff Development Officer of MMI, now Allianz Australia Ltd. Mark was studying training and development part-time, when his life was taken in a tragic accident. This scholarship fund was set up by Mark's colleagues with the support of MMI.

The Mark Pompei Scholarship of \$1,000 is awarded annually to assist individuals to pursue their career in training and development.

A complimentary ticket to the 2016 AITD National Conference and a one-year AITD Student Membership is included as part of the scholarship.

Specific Award Criteria

Nominations will be judged on the specific criteria below. Each criterion has been allocated points that the judges will use to assess the entry. If any of these criteria are not met the submission will not be considered.

Examples of supporting evidence have been provided to assist you in completing your application. These suggestions are examples only and not a definitive list.

Criterion	Description	Supporting Evidence Examples
Enrolment 30 Points	Describe your enrolment as a part-time student of an accredited formal study program working towards a first qualification in the field of training and development.	Proof of enrolment
Achievement 30 Points	Describe your most significant achievements in the area of learning and development. These achievements can be academic, work-related, voluntary work, or a combination of these.	Evidence of academic achievements, career milestones, testimonials, recommendations.
Commitment 20 Points	Describe how you have demonstrated commitment to a career in adult education, learning and development.	Personal goals and milestones. KPI reports or performance reviews. Employment information. Testimonials.
Recommendation 20 Points	Applicants will need to obtain a short statement of support, from an academic referee /sponsor.	Referee report describing the achievements and potential of the nominee.
