r Denise Meyerson, Director of Management Consultancy International, is an entrepreneur, mentor and renowned speaker and author. She is known and respected for pioneering new methodologies, mindsets and paradigms to enable learning and development professionals to introduce exciting and innovative learning experiences. As a global master trainer of the LEGO® Serious Play process, Denise remains at the forefront of handson, minds-on learning that engages participants of all levels.

With over 25 years' experience, Denise promotes the importance of training to corporate clients and individual students. She ensures that the community remains updated on the very latest learning trends through free briefing and information sessions - over 400 professionals attended these events over 18 months.

Denise set about improving student completion rates and created an online simulated work environment. Students are able to access policies and procedures and feel as though they work in a real organisation, facing realistic challenges. ABCN provides structured mentoring programs for school students by partnering them with business professionals. She mentors students about the critical importance of education in their career progression. In 2015, she facilitated a session for 60 Year 11 girls from underprivileged schools.

She has published two books on learning and development tools and techniques. Giving back to the community is a key driver for Denise contributing financially and by donating her time to not-for-profit organisations. In 2015, she gave her time at 16 donor evenings with a charity organisation. Hundreds of copies of Denise's first book were provided at no charge to the community so that playful and fun activities become more commonplace in training rooms across the country.
